The Summer University of the Foundation for Continental Law is the new and international, yearly meeting place for persons interested in continental legal culture, whether they are academic scholars, legal professionals, or students.

Audience

The Summer University focuses on **students** having completed their legal studies' cycle, on **professors** and **professionals**.

Useful information

Location and Dates

The summer University is held in Paris, at the Sorbonne, from **Monday, July 6 to Saturday, July 25, 2009**. The session lasts **3 weeks**. Certain candidates may be excused from the first week of class, upon their request and following review of their application.

Application

The **application forms** are downloadable from the Foundation for Continental Law's website (www.fondation-droitcontinental.org). The application form must be submitted to the Foundation no later than March 30 2009. The selection of candidates is made under the authority of the international Scientific Council of the Foundation.

The registration fees include tuition fees and, depending on the option chosen, board and lodging. However, meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) are not provided on Saturdays and Sundays.

Accommodation is provided at the Cité Internationale Universitaire de Paris.

Travel to Paris and trip expenses are at the expense of the participants.

The training session

The training session lasts three weeks, and includes 9 courses consisting of 10 hours each, for a total of **90 hours**.

Conferences and seminars are scheduled so as to provide even greater depth to the course materials.

The courses are taught by high-level specialists, eminent in continental law and in comparative law. The courses, each lasting 10 hours, are conducted in French or in English, depending on the subject matter and the speakers.

First week *

- Introduction to comparative law, by Pr Rodolfo Sacco, Italy,
- Introduction to Roman-based Law, by Pr Xavier Blanc-Jouvan, France,
- Introduction to the Asian Legal Culture, by Pr Marie Goré, France.

* Certain candidates may be excused from the first week of classes, upon their request and following review of their application.

Second week

- International and European Law of Contracts, by Pr Joachim Bonell, Italy,
- Comparative Constitutional Law, by Pr Vlad Constantinesco, France,
- Recent Aspects of the law on Bioethics, by Pr Florence Bellivier, and Christine Noiville, research Director at the CNRS, France.

Third week

- Administrative Contracts, a Comparative Perspective, by Pr Frédéric Rolin, France,
- International Litigation Regulation, by Pr Pierre Tercier, Suisse,
- Fundamental rights, Individual and Family rights, by Pr Benoît Moore, Quebec.

Certificate

Exams are mandatory for students and optional for the other participants. A Certificate of Completion of Training in Continental Law will be issued by the Summer University.

Cultural activities

Cultural activities will be proposed during the training session, such as the visit of the highest institutions of French law and a tour of Paris.
